The 1874 Drawing Map shows a different 2 story building here. It looks like it was built by Joseph Gallena as a saloon/hotel.

Joseph and James Gallena, both plasterer's, both listed here in 1884/1885 directory. Joseph Gallena, saloon keeper, & James Gallena, bds, listed here in 1886/1887 directory (along with possibly Harry Woods). Foster's Brockville Directory of 1895-1896 calls this building the Gallena Block.
