GORRELL COMPLEX - 72-77 Perth St. - built c.1870 Andrew Gorrell (1807-1871) was a carpenter, and so would have had a major hand in building this structure. Married to the former Christian Smith, they had at

least 5 children, Elizabeth, James Robert, Anne Bell, George Taylor and Charles E. He owned this lot since before 1861 and it originally had two buildings side by side. Sometime around 1870 (but probably mid to late 1860s), Gorrell replaced the two buildings with this large 4 unit complex.

After Andrew's death, it seams that his son, and 4th child, George Taylor Gorrell (1844–1897), a mail clerk, inherited the building. Records show he lived on Perth in the 1870s. George was married to the former Catherine Fulton (1846–1913) and they had 7 children, Arthur Stirling, Lt. Col. Charles Willson Farran (M.D.), Gertrude, Catharine Cecil Maud, Claude and Gerald.

The Gorrell's probably occupied the larger unit, now #76, which seems to be the "mother" unit in the early days when the owner lived in the building. An early resident (possible owner) was barber Walter Fraser (#76*). He married Mary Russell (1854–1942) and they had 10 children. The Fraser's were there

from c.1880 to c.1905. Other early residents from the 1880s were Mrs Elizabeth McLelland, Mrs M.J. Smith and Miss Kate Clifford. Shortly after the millennium, junk dealer George Henry Vout (1847–1936) was in #76. He and wife, former Lucinda Bishop (1854–1937) had 15 children. At this

time their 4th child, George Henry Vout Jr. (1879–1957) was in #74 and 9th child Alonzo Vout (1886–1956) lived in #78. I would speculate that Vout at #76 owned the building with family members in 3/4 of the units. The Vout's moved out of all three units around 1911. Around 1926, three of the four units were vacant. That suggests to me that there was a major renovation going on. There could have even been a small fire that

Labourer James Wotherspoon and his wife Pearl were one of the longest renters, in #74, from c.1927 to c.1954. Charles E. Ranger, who worked at Phillips' Elect Works, moved into #78 around 1930. He and his wife, the former Barbara Margaret McKay, had one child, Isabel. The Rangers were there up until about 1946. His brother **John Ranger** and wife **Hattie** moved into #76 in the same time period, c.1933 to c.1943,

brought it on, not affecting the far left unit (#72), but that is only speculation.

much needed major renovations took place with new siding installed on the outside.


afterwards moving to Water St. The Red Top Meat Shop was located in #76 from around 2003 to beyond 2007. Robin Crump lived in the upper portion of that unit, but unsure if she had the meat business. The two southern units went empty in the early 1990s and stayed empty until after 2007. The other two units had renters with the last names of Hopkins,

Perrin, Smith, Durant, Duffy, Young and Groulx. The building was clearly in decline. The units began being sold off to occupants c.1952. All four units were owned by their individual occupants, for the first time, c.1970. One result of this is the individual units taking on different look as opposed to a unified look. As time went on, it became quite shabby. It recently came under one owner again, In 2024,

Being rentals for most of its history, tenents came and went with very short stays through the years. Too numerous for here. The Gorrell Complex is being renovated by Torri Lee Duffy in 2024, with fresh new outside siding.

There are two letters on the building. First we have the letter A on the window tops. We can safely say it stands for "Andrew" as in original owner Andrew Gorrell. Next we have the letter M. I found no one around the Gorrell's that it could be attributed to. It's meaning is lost to history at this point. It could even be just a cornice design that looks like an M (unlikely).
